


FLHealthCHARTS.com Statistical Brief Suicide Deaths in Florida

Description

In 2017 there were 3,187 deaths in Florida due to suicide. Among the rankable causes of death suicide was the 8th highest. The age adjusted death rate per 100,000 population (AADR) for suicide in 2017 was 14.1.

Graph 1 below shows the Suicide AADRs for Florida for 1970 through 2017.

The AADR for suicide reached an all-time low at 12.3 per 100,000 population in 2005. Since then the AADR has increased consistently and was 14.1 in 2017. In percentage terms the 2017 AADR of 14.1 is 15% higher than the AADR of 12.3 in 2005.

Suicide rates were highest for White males and lowest for Black females. Table 1 below shows the age adjusted suicide rates by race and sex for the years 2015 – 2017 combined.





Suicide rates vary by age as shown in the graphs 2 and 3 below.



Note that the vertical scale for graphs 2 and 3 is the same. The shorter bars in graph 3 illustrate the generally lower rates for both white and Black females compared to males in graph 2.

Suicide rates also vary geographically. The map below displays suicide age-adjusted death rates per 100,000 population by county for Florida 2015 through 2017.

Discussion

Suicide rates have generally decreased since 1975 but have trended up in the period 2005 through 2017. Suicide risk varies greatly by age, race and gender, as well as geographically. In the period 2015 - 2017 White males had the highest rates and Black females have the lowest rates. The rate for White males was 13 times the rate for Black females (Table 1).
