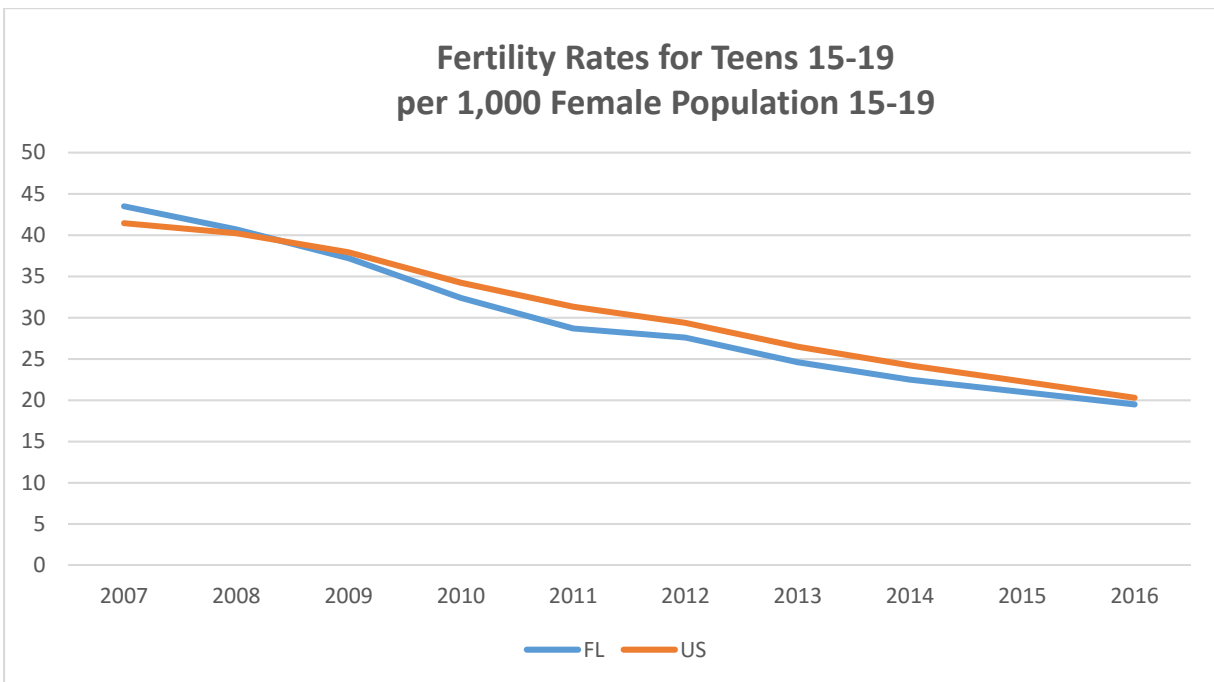
Teen Birth Rates in Florida Decreased Substantially in the Last 10 Years

From 2007 to 2016 Florida's teen fertility rate decreased steadily and was 55.2% lower in 2016 than in 2007.

- In 2007 there were 25,688 births to mothers age 15 to 19. This computes to a fertility rate of 43.5 births per 1,000 females age 15 to 19.
- In 2016, there were 11,186 births to mothers age 15 to 19. This computes to a fertility rate of 19.5 births per 1,000 females age 15 to 19.

The U.S. fertility rate for teens age 15 to 19 was 41.46 in 2007 and decreased by 51% to 20.31 in 2016.

- The U.S. rate started lower but ended higher than the Florida rate for the 10 years 2007 to 2016.
