

About the FloridaCHARTS.com Marriage Dissolution Query System

The Marriage Dissolution Query System provides counts and rates of dissolutions from 1989 to the present. Provisional data is updated every morning at approximately 5:00 a.m. In this system, if there are no values for the variable selected, then no data will be displayed. Where row, column and filter variables appear to be duplicated, they actually reflect data from each of the spouse fields on the record.

To present data consistent with Florida legislation and current certificates of marriage and dissolution of marriage, the term spouse is used rather than bride and groom/wife and husband. Each of the spouse fields represents a different partner in the marriage or dissolution. However, neither field is exclusively designated to the husband or wife.
